Glossary

Medical Management - The process where an individual receives guidance and management of health care services obtained through a health care plan.

Utilization Review - The process of reviewing the health care process in order to guarantee that the best possible outcome was obtained for the patient.

Pre-Certification (Pre-Utilization)- The process of pre-certifying medical procedures and tests. Each employer has different pre-utilization requirements, so check with your plan to see what procedures require pre-utilization review.

Condition Manager - A professional nurse who is responsible for coordinating medical care. Each employer group is assigned a dedicated nurse or nurses, who are supported by a clinical team.

Employer Health Plan - Comprehensive Health Care Package provided by an employer for their employees and dependents. ICM's services are included in your health plan.
